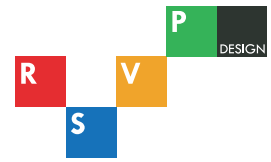


Towards the Creation of Rich Environments for Active Learning: A demonstration of activity-based learning tools, and a new product innovation session
